Certificates & Credentials -
Vocationally Based Education
(Some degrees focus on job preparation)



Doctorate Degree

(= 3-6 Years of full-time study
after MA/MS)
Advanced specialization

Masters Degree

(= 2-3 Years of full-time study
after BA/BS)
Specialization in one subject
(People commonly change direction [majors] at this point)

College Graduate (definition = Holds a Bachelor's Degree)

Bachelors Degree

(= 4 Years of full-time study)
2 years general education
+2 years concentration in one subject (*Major*)

Associates Degree

(= 2 Years of full-time study)
General Education +
Introductory Information in One Subject (*Major*)

College Degrees -
Academically Based Education
(Some degrees focus on advancement of knowledge)

Required for grades K —12

Associates Degree

Required for early childhood education
